AGRIDIGITAL

is the association which represents the manufacturers of solutions and services based on digital technologies for agricultural and garden machinery.



ASSOIDROTECH

is the association which represents the manufacturers of systems, machinery and technologies for irrigation in agriculture and gardening.



ASSOMAO

is the association which represents the manufacturers of implements for: tilling, seeding, transplanting, fertilizing, crop protection, harvesting, first processing after harvesting, livestock raising and handling and transport.



ASSOMASE

is the association which groups the manufacturers of self-propelled machines (all agricultural machinery with one or more axles and powered by an engine, other than tractors).



ASSOTRATTORI

is the association which groups the manufacturers of tractors



COMACOMP

is the association which groups manufacturers of: mechanical components, hydraulic components, electric-electronic components, miscellaneous components, irrigation components and spraying components.



COMAGARDEN

is the association which groups manufacturers of garden machinery.

Product categories falling within the scope of the Federation include machinery, other than tractors, for: soil-working; sowing, transplanting and fertilizer distribution; crop protection; irrigation; harvesting; first processing and conditioning of products; livestock husbandry; handling and transport; forestry and agricultural and forest biomass treatment. In the garden sector the Federation counts the national industry of equipment for professional and hobbyist greenkeeping whilst in the wide sector of componentry represents the manufacturing companies of components or systems of components for OEM or spare parts for agricultural and garden machinery.

Lastly, it includes the digital technologies sector applied to agriculture for the development of increasingly productive and sustainable agricultural systems.
